**Scales (30 marks)**

- Three scales; one student's choice, two teacher's choices
- One octave ascending & descending of:
  - all major scales (**MEMORIZED**)
  - minor scales (harmonic & melodic)
  - chromatic scale, whole tone scale, blues scale

**Study (15 marks)**

- As assigned
- To be prepared individually

**Solo (45 marks)**

- As assigned
- To be prepared individually

**Sight Reading (10 marks)**

- Perform an unknown passage using rhythms practiced in class and key signatures of exam scales, once only.

Total: 100 marks
